



Rules Summer Camp 2020 ASMV

MANDATORY: To bring signed and dated on the first day

- The camp starts on June, Monday 22nd and ends on Friday August 21st. June 24th and July 1st are a holiday day, no camp will be available. Please respect the week (s) you have registered for. The camp schedule is from 9:00am to 3:30pm and day care is available from 8:00am to 9:00am and from 3:30pm to 5:00pm for a price of \$20 per week for a 4 days camp and \$25 for a 5 days camp.
- You must respect the opening and closing hours. A fee of \$ 5 per 15 minutes late will be required before your child returns to day camp. These fees will be payable to the on-site monitors/coaches in cash.
- The ASMV Summer camp will not be responsible for children arriving before the opening of the day care service.
- In order to promote planning and participation in activities, we ask you to drop your children to camp by 9:00am at the latest. If for any reason you need to bring your child after 9:00 am, please send an email at administration@socccerverdun.com, cc dt@socccerverdun.com
- The morning reception is at Archambault or Beurling park depending on the week. The afternoon departure will take place at Centre Elgar for children registered on Nun's Island and at Beurling Park for children registered in Verdun. If there is heavy rain we will send an email out the day before to inform you if you have to drop your child in the morning at the Elgar Center (Salle Saules) for Nuns' Island and for Verdun it's the same park but in Chalet Beurling.
- Make sure your child brings everything he/she needs for lunch and snacks (one cold meal and two snacks per day): no candy, no peanut products please. Thank you for your understanding. In addition, it is important for your child to have sunscreen protector and a hat. If you feel necessary, please feel free to bring extra clothing for your child. (Please, identify all your child's belongings). If your child comes by bike, please ensure to provide him/her with a lock.

- Please notify the monitor/coach if anyone other than you will come to pick your child up. Thank you for communicating your logistics with the monitors/coaches who are in the field when you drop your child in the morning.
- The day camp is a service we offer to children to enjoy summer together; we are under no obligation to tolerate children who interfere with the proper functioning of the group. If this is the case, the parent will be notified by the technical director. An intervention plan will be proposed. If the problematic behavior persists despite the warning and the application of the intervention plan, ASMV Summer Camp reserve the right to exclude the child for the rest of the season without reimbursement.
- We ask you to keep your child at home in case of illness (fever, gastritis, otitis, lice, etc ...). If this is the case, we would be thankful to be informed.
- If your child becomes sick during the day, we will contact you and you should be able to do the necessary arrangements.
- An attendance sheet will be available for parents and monitors/coaches every morning. Please do not leave in the morning without having completed and / or signed this sheet.
